

CONNECTING TO WIRELESS INTERNET

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the steps below to connect to wireless internet from your Windows device.

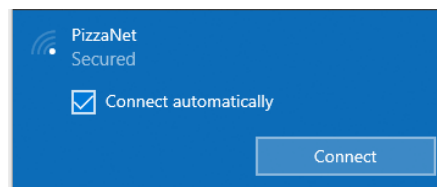
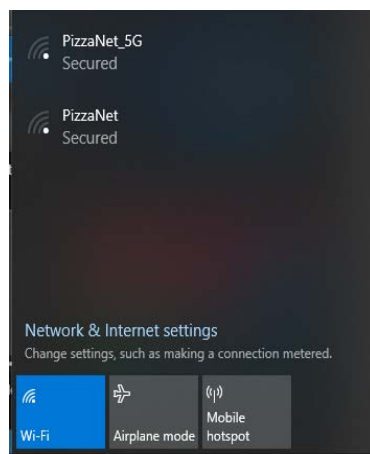
STEP 1

Locate the wireless icon at the bottom right of your screen. Click on that icon, and you should see a list of available wireless networks. It should look something like these icons:



STEP 2

Find your work or home wireless network on the list of available networks. Click on it, and then click “Connect”.



STEP 3

Enter in the network security key, also known as wireless key, or WiFi password. Click “Next” once you have entered in the security key.

- If this is a work connection, you can reach out to Grade A for assistance in finding the network security key.
- If this is a personal home connection and you are unsure of the security key, you may need to reach out to the home owner or whoever set up the wireless router.

Once connected to wireless, you should be able to begin browsing the internet and connecting to VPN.
